Complainant being duly sworn, states that Chance R. Keysor on or about April 8th, 2025 in Mercer County, Ohio, did; No person shall recklessly cause inconvenience, annoyance, or alarm to another by doing any of the following: Engaging in fighting, in threatening harm to persons or property, or in violent or turbulent behavior; Making unreasonable noise or an offensively coarse utterance, gesture, or display or communicating unwarranted and grossly abusive language to any person. The offender persists in disorderly conduct after reasonable warning or request to desist. To Wit: Chance R. Keysor persisted in disorderly conduct after being warned to desist. Deputies were called out to the residence the day prior for a dispute between Chance and Victim #1. Chance and Victim #1 were warned for Disorderly Conduct. Today, Chance was yelling at Victim #1 and threatening to have someone come cause physical harm to Victim #1. Later Chance came out of his room and started to approach Victim #1. Victim #1 used their phone to record Chance due to his behavior. Chance then smacked the phone out of Victim #1's hands. This in contrary to and in violation of the Ohio Revised Code section ~~§2917.11~~³⁴ (3)(A), titled Persistent Disorderly Conduct, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree. 2917.11 (E)(3)(4)
