Complainant being duly sworn states that Jeremy E. Hague, in Mercer County, Ohio, on or about March 14, 2025, unlawfully

did recklessly violate the terms of a protection order issued or consent agreement approved pursuant to section 2919.26 or 3113.31 of the Revised Code.


FURTHERMORE, Jeremy E. Hague previously had been convicted of, pleaded guilty to, or been adjudicated a delinquent child for three violations of Section 2919.27, to wit: May 21, 2024 in Celina Municipal Court, Mercer County, Ohio, of ORC 2919.27(A)(1), Violating a Protection Order, in case number 24CRB00139 and July 26, 2024 in Celina Municipal Court, Mercer County, Ohio, of ORC 2919.27(A)(1), Violating a Protection Order, in case number 24CRB00246 and November 1, 2024 in the Court of Common Pleas, Mercer County, Ohio, of ORC 2919.27(A)(1), Violating a Protection Order, in case number 24-CRM-109


The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.





I, Chief Jared L. Laux, do hereby state that I am employed at the Fort Recovery Police Department. The following did occur:


On March 14, 2025, at approximately 7:50 A.M, I was notified by Officer Wyerick that he saw Jeremy Hague in the alley, in the 100 Block of East Broadway Street, in the Village of Fort Recovery, Mercer County, Ohio. I am familiar with Jeremy Hague and was aware that there was a protection order that was issued, saying that Jeremy could not be within 500 feet of Victim # 1, or a place where she might be. Victim # 1 resides at 117 East Broadway Street, Lot number 41.

I responded to that area. While travelling there, I confirmed through the Mercer County Central Dispatch that the protection order was still in place. When I arrived, I found Jeremy. Jeremy admitted that he knew that he wasn't supposed to be there and went on to say that he has been living with Victim # 1, who is the protected person named in the protection order.


I arrested Hague and transported him to the Mercer County Detention Facility. I later researched the distance and found it to be approximately 310 Feet.
