§2925.03(A)(2), 2925.03(C)(9)(c)

Date of Offense On or about February 8, 2025

The Jurors of the Grand Jury of the State of Ohio, within and for the body of Mercer County, IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF Ohio, do find and present, that Jessica A. Landon, on or about February 8, 2025 in Mercer County, Ohio unlawfully did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a controlled substance or a controlled substance analog, when the offender knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance or a controlled substance analog is intended for sale or resale by the offender or another person and the drug involved in the violation was a fentanyl-related compound or a compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing a fentanyl-related compound and the amount of the drug involved equals or exceeds ten unit doses but is less than fifty unit doses.

FURTHERMORE, and the offense was committed in the vicinity of a juvenile.

did knowingly prepare for shipment, ship, transport, deliver, prepare for distribution, or distribute a controlled substance or a controlled substance analog, when the offender knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the controlled substance or a controlled substance analog is intended for sale or resale by the offender or another person and the drug involved in the violation is heroin or a compound, mixture, preparation, or substance containing heroin and the amount of the drug involved is less than 10 unit doses.

FURTHERMORE, the offense was committed in the vicinity of a juvenile.

The offense is contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

Endangering Children - M1

On or about February 8, 2025






