AFFIDAVIT ON COMPLAINT (O.R.C. 2935.09)

STATE OF OHIO, MERCER COUNTY, SS:

I, do hereby state that I am employed at the Celina Police Department. The following did occur:

On September 6, 2024, at approximately 8:06 A.M, I was dispatched to a business called Arco, on South Main Street in the City of Celina, Mercer County, Ohio, to take a theft report.

Victim # 1 said that her light blue Schwinn bicycle was stolen from the rear of the business at approximately 6:00 A.M. Victim #1 had video of the suspect inside the store and outside the store, including the theft of the bike and leaving, Southbound. Victim # 1 estimated the value of the bike at approximately \$300.

I sent still photos of the suspect to other agencies to see if anyone recognized him. Det. Kraner from St. Mary's Police Department called and told me it was a Zach Swisher.

Shortly after this, Det. Brian Taylor saw a male, matching the description of the suspect, riding a blue bike on Magnolia Street, in Celina. Det.
